


4. Vocabulary: locomotor mortis

locomotive: 1. Of or relating to travel, 2. A self-propelled vehicle that runs on rails and is used for moving railroad cars (such as a steam locomotive).

locomote: to move about (animals locomote; trees don't).

- **locate:** To find, place or indicate where something is (locate a missing person, locate a house in a certain town).
- **local:** of or relating to a certain place or the area around you (the local schools, a local doctor).
- **relocate:** to locate again; to establish in a new place (relocated refugees from a war; relocate yourself when your family moves).
- **dislocate:** To put out of place; to separate a bone from its usual connection with another bone (dislocated shoulders, knees and fingers).
- **allocate:** to set aside or designate for a special reason (allocate money for books, allocate food for children).
- **locale:** location, especially connected to a certain event (the locale for the buzzard festival).
